HAZARDOUS WASTE

Hazardous waste is any product that is labeled as harmful, toxic, poisonous, combustible, corrosive, flammable, or irritant. HHW items include the following: Fluorescent Bulbs/Tubes, Lamps, Sharps, Paint, Alkaline & Rechargeable Batteries, Mercury/Lead Devices, Automobile Oil/Filter, Antifreeze/Coolant, Solvents. These products **CANNOT** be placed in your recycling, green waste, or garbage cart/containers. These materials should be disposed of safely and properly.

RECYCLING LAWS AB 341 & AB 1826

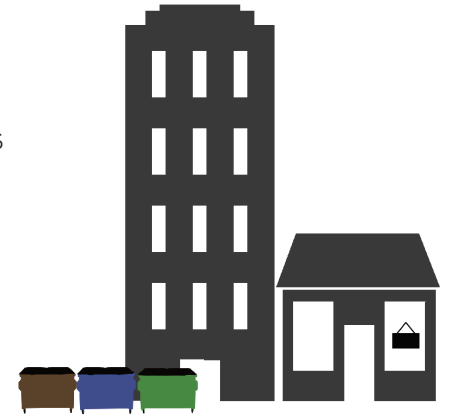
BUSINESSES & MULTI-FAMILIES

Is your business in compliance with state laws? Depending on the amount of solid waste produced on a weekly basis, you may need to add recycling and organic services.

Recycling Law AB 341 became effective July 1, 2012. AB 341 requires businesses and public entities that generate four cubic yards or more of solid waste per week and multi-family properties with five or more units to add a recycling program to their waste services.

Recycling Law AB 1826 went into effect in 2016. AB 1826 requires businesses and schools that generate 4 or more cubic yards of solid waste per week to implement an organics recycling program, with full implementation realized in 2019.

Businesses and multi-family properties are required to comply with these laws by implementing a diversion program with waste haulers. If you are a commercial business without recycling or organic services and would like to confirm whether or not you are in compliance, please contact Mid Valley Disposal at **(559) 567-0520**.



BACK TO THE BASICS

It is likely that your business or home has seen a reduction in the type of materials that are accepted in your **blue recycle container**. Due to changes in the recycling markets, Mid Valley Disposal has had to narrow the range of materials allowed to be disposed of in the **blue recycle containers**. We encourage all to continue to sort and recycle and to be aware of accepted materials. Failing to do so may result in contamination tags and potential contamination penalties. Recycling is going "Back to the Basics" and when in doubt refer to the diagram on the right. Materials that are not represented should be thrown into the trash bin/cart.
