California's Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law AB341



It is important for businesses, schools districts, and multi-family apartments to understand the new California law AB341. AB341 requires commercial and public entities that generate 4 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week and multi-family apartments with 5 or more units to subscribe to recycling services by July 1, 2012.



Below are a few frequently asked questions that may help you to understand the new mandatory commercial recycling law.

Frequently Asked Questions:

- How do I know if I am included in this mandate?
- If you are a commercial business or public entity (schools, multi family complexes with 5 or more units) and your business generates 4 cubic yards or more of solid waste per week, you will be subject to mandatory recycling.
- When will this State Law be put into effect?
 - This mandatory recycling State law will go into effect July 1, 2012.
- **2 3** How do I comply with AB341? Separate your recyclables from the trash and place in your recycling bin or cart.
