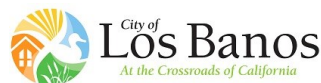

Self-Haul and Waiver Certification Form

Property owners/businesses who receive self-haul and waiver certification approval are subject to annual inspections. The City may revoke self-haul and waiver certification if it determined that you or your independent hauler is not properly recycling and you may be required to subscribe with Mid Valley Disposal

Applicant acknowledges that removal of one or more services, recycling and/or organics will not result in a lower monthly service fee. Solid waste collection services negotiated with the City is a “bundled” service.

Assembly Bill 341, multiple dwellings, 5 units or more including businesses that generate four (4) cubic yards or more of solid waste per week to subscribe for recycling services.

Assembly Bills 1826, multiple dwellings, 5 units or more including businesses schools and public entities that generate two (2) cubic yards or more of commercial solid waste per week to subscribe for organic waste recycling services.

Senate Bill 1383, California’s Mandatory Recycling and Organic Waste Disposal Reduction Laws and require single family and multiple family properties, businesses including schools and public entities to subscribe for organic waste recycling services.

SB1383 requires businesses and multiple family dwellings, 5 units or more who self-haul or use haulers who collect their organic waste to do the following:

- ◆ **Source separate all organic waste generated onsite or hauled to a high diversion organic waste processing facility.**
- ◆ **A record (delivery receipts and weight tickets) of the amount of organic waste (cubic yards or tons) delivered to a solid waste facility, operation, activity or property that processes or recovers organic waste.**
- ◆ **Record must be kept for five (5) years and is subject to inspection by the jurisdiction.**
