Property owners/businesses who receive self-haul and waiver certification approval are subject to annual inspections.

Assembly Bill 341

Multiple dwellings and apartments with 5 units or more, including businesses that generate four (4) cubic yards or more of solid waste per week, must subscribe to recycling services.

Assembly Bill 1826

Multiple dwellings and apartments with 5 units or more, schools, or public entities and businesses that generate two (2) cubic yards or more of solid waste per week, must subscribe to organic waste recycling services.

Senate Bill 1383

California's Mandatory recycling and organic waste disposal reduction laws require single family and multiple family properties, businesses, schools, and public entities to subscribe to organic waste recycling services. SB1383 requires businesses and multiple family dwellings who self-haul or use landscapers to collect their organic waste to do the following:

- Source separate all organic waste generated onsite or hauled to a high diversion organic waste processing facility.
- Keep detailed record (delivery receipts and weight tickets) of the amount of organic waste (cubic yards or tons) delivered to a solid waste facility, operation, activity or property that processes or recovers organic waste. Record must be kept for five (5) years and is subject to inspection by the jurisdiction.



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
